Sound Device	What it is	Example
Rhyme	end or final sounds are the same	<p>Whose woods these are I think I know.</p> <p>His house is in the village though;</p> <p>He will not see me stopping here</p> <p>To watch his woods fill up with snow.</p>
Repetition	word, phrase or sentence is repeated	<p><i>The best kinds of people</i> are warm and kind, They are always there and they never mind.</p> <p><i>The best kinds of people</i> smile and embrace, They support you with strength and grace.</p>
Onomatopoeia	imitate the sounds	<p>Zoom! Whoosh.. Boom!</p> <p>Crackle, crackle, crackle.</p> <p>Ooo! Ah!</p> <p>Whoosh... Boom!</p> <p>Squeal, squeal, squeal.</p> <p>Ha, ha, ha, ha, ha!</p>
Alliteration	repeats beginning sound	<p>Bubbly baby Bradley</p> <p>And Annie's sister Abbey</p> <p>Made a mess in Mab's house</p>

<p>Simile</p>	<p>compares two things using like or as</p>	<p>My brother is like a tornado.</p> <p>He always moves fast and spreads destruction wherever he goes.</p> <p>My sister is like a snowstorm.</p> <p>She's icy at times, but with a little sunshine, that iciness melts.</p>
<p>Metaphor</p>	<p>compares things using is, are, was, were</p>	<p>I thought it rather strange today, When visiting the zoo, To find the creatures living there, Are just like me and you.</p>
<p>Personification</p>	<p>When animals or objects have human qualities</p>	<p>animals that talk My alarm clock yells at me every morning.</p> <p>My house is a friend who protects me.</p> <p>The moon played hide and seek with the clouds</p>
<p>Imagery</p>	<p>Visually descriptive, senses (see, hear, touch, taste, feel)</p>	<p>As Mommy washed up and the children played, smell of warm butter filled the air.</p>
<p>Hyperbole</p>	<p>exaggerated statements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● It was so cold I saw polar bears wearing jackets. ● I am so hungry I could eat a horse. ● I had a ton of chores to do.

Idiom	Phrase not to be taken literally	Sick as a dog - means you are very ill Idioms that refer to your actions would be: Rub someone the wrong way - meaning to annoy or bother
